

NOT FEELING WELL

Take the student's temperature.

Is the student's temperature equal or greater than 100.4° oral/tympanic (ear), temporal (forehead) axillary (armpit)?

YES

See "**FEVER.**"

NO

- Have the student lie down in a room that affords privacy but allows for adult supervision.
- Allow the student to rest for up to 15 minutes.
- Observe the student, if other symptoms develop, refer to appropriate protocol.

Is the student feeling better?

NO

YES

Allow the student to return to class.

Contact responsible school authority & parent/guardian.

- If unable to reach parent/guardian, allow student to rest with adult supervision.
- Monitor temperature every hour.
- If temperature reaches 105° orally/tympanic/axillary, or temporal **CALL EMS/911.**
